### **What am I committing to as a Leader for CIY MIX?**

Camp is an amazing opportunity to invest in the lives of our students. Through group times, recreation, and free time, there are so many opportunities for our team of adult leaders to get to know our students in ways that aren't always possible in weekly programming at Parkview. Think of it as a way to "fast track" relationships.

Our hope is leaders can help students grow closer to one another as well by being an example. Leaders set the tone when it comes to encouraging participation and engaging in meaningful community throughout the week.

FYI: Leaders are never roomed with students, and are always assigned to groups with at least 1 other leader.

### **What are MIX's rules?**

1. Respect others and yourself.
2. No guys in girls' dorms beyond the front lobby and vice versa.
3. Alcohol, tobacco, vaping, drugs, and weapons are absolutely prohibited.
4. You must be in his or her dorm by the designated "In Dorm Time" on the schedule.
5. For security reasons, no students with backpacks are allowed into the auditorium or cafeteria.
6. Drawstring bags are acceptable.
7. Follow the schedule. Be where you are supposed to be when you are supposed to be there.
8. During sessions, stay in your assigned seating area. Please follow the posted seating chart.
9. Do not leave the auditorium once the speakers begin talking.
10. Respect the campus – no TP, water balloons, shaving cream, sidewalk chalk, etc.
11. No practical jokes!
12. Don't move furniture - you will be charged for any assessed damage.

13. Don't dial 911 unless it is a true emergency.
14. Absolutely no fireworks at any time during MIX or while on campus property.
15. No deliveries of any kind to the campus.
16. Students may leave campus ONLY with adult supervision; those staying behind must have an adult present.
17. Follow the MIX dress code.
18. No hazing of any kind will be tolerated.

The adult leaders for each group are ultimately responsible for ensuring students follow the MIX and campus rules. MIX reserves the right to dismiss any youth or adult leader who cannot abide by these rules.

- 1) Register through Parkview's leader registration page ([parkviewchurch.com/students](http://parkviewchurch.com/students))
- 2) Fill out required forms
  - a. Parkview Students Leader Waiver: Completed during registration process
  - b.
