What is a week of MOVE like?

Day 1 (Monday)

- ☐ Afternoon check-in
- ☐ Dinner
- ☐ Evening Session (worship, games & message)
- ☐ Group time
- ☐ Outer Realm Games

Day 2-Day 4 (Tuesday-Thursday)

- ☐ 3 meals on-campus each day
- ☐ Morning and evening main sessions (worship, games & message)
- ☐ Group time after each session
- ☐ Tournaments & Recreation Activities

Day 5 (Friday)

- ☐ Depart after evening session

What am I committing to as a Leader for CIY MOVE?

Camp is an amazing opportunity to invest in the lives of our students. Through group times, recreation, and free time, there are so many opportunities for our team of adult leaders to get to know our students in ways that aren't always possible in weekly programming at Parkview. Think of it as a way to "fast track" relationships.

Our hope is leaders can help students grow closer to one another as well by being an example. Leaders set the tone when it comes to encouraging participation and engaging in meaningful community throughout the week.

Leaders assist with:

- ☐ Group Time
- ☐ Recreation options
- ☐ General supervision around campus and in dorms

FYI: Leaders are never roomed with students, and are always assigned to groups with at least 1 other leader.

Co-leaders are expected to work together to ensure the students in their group have the best possible experience during the week of MOVE. Leaders are key! We appreciate you!

What will my high schooler need for MOVE?

WHAT TO BRING:

- ☐ Bible
- ☐ Notebook and pen/pencil
- ☐ Clothing for five days, including travel time
- ☐ Personal toiletry items, including prescription medication
- ☐ Towel
- ☐ Bedding/sleeping bag to fit a single bed
- ☐ Money for travel, the MOVE Store, offering, etc
- ☐ (optional) Athletic attire for recreation time

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- ❑ Alcohol, cigarettes, drugs, vapes, etc
- ❑ Refrigerators, TV's, fireworks, or air-conditioners

What are MOVE's rules?

1. Respect others and yourself.
2. No guys in girls' dorms beyond the front lobby and vice versa.
3. Alcohol, tobacco, vaping, drugs, and weapons are absolutely prohibited.
4. Everyone must be in his or her dorm by the designated "In Dorm Time."
5. For security reasons, no students with backpacks are allowed into the auditorium or cafeteria.
6. Follow the schedule. Be where you are supposed to be when you are supposed to be there.
7. During sessions, stay in your church's assigned seating area. Please follow the posted seating chart.
8. Do not leave the auditorium once the speakers begin talking.
9. Respect the campus – no TP, water balloons, shaving cream, sidewalk chalk, etc. No practical jokes.
10. Do not move furniture. You will be charged for venue staff moving it back.
11. Do not dial 911 unless it is a true emergency.
12. Absolutely no fireworks at any time during MOVE or while on campus property.
13. No deliveries of any kind to the campus.
14. Students may leave campus ONLY with adult supervision; those staying behind must have an adult present.
15. Follow the MOVE dress code.
16. No hazing of any kind will be tolerated.

The adult leaders for each group are ultimately responsible for ensuring students follow the MOVE and campus rules. MOVE reserves the right to dismiss any youth or adult leader who cannot abide by these rules.

UNACCEPTABLE

- ☐ Spaghetti straps
- ☐ Low-cut shirts
- ☐ Short shorts
- ☐ Short skirts
- ☐ Bikinis
